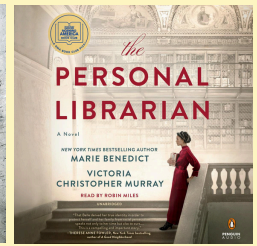
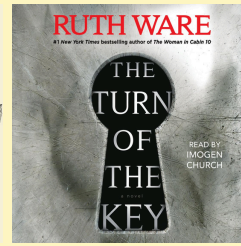
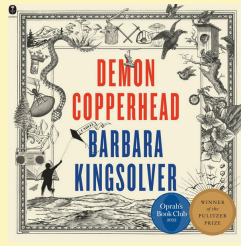
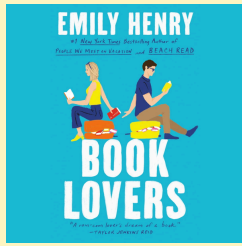
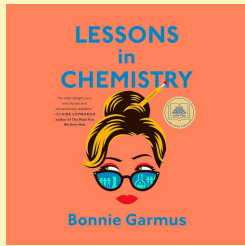
Mingle with Kringle

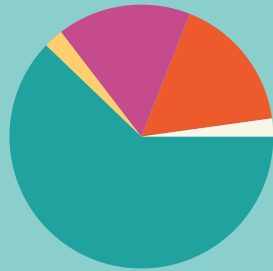

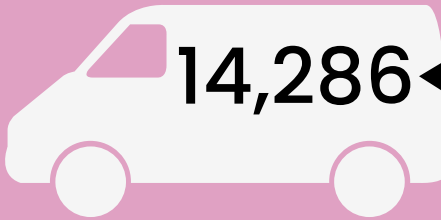

Geneva Writes

The Foundation was established in 2011 as a vehicle for investment in market securities. While our focus remains on long-term financial support, each year our undertakings evolve to meet both the Library's current needs and the skills of the organization's leadership and volunteers.

In its twelfth year, the Foundation engaged in a successful appeal to Library donors and patrons. At the close of the campaign on February 28, 2023, we had raised \$26,713 from 130 donors. A portion of these funds enabled the Foundation to increase its effort to continue accumulating an Endowment Fund.

In 2023, our fundraising event, A Taste of Jazz, was a sell-out and raised \$2,635. Our Spring book sale raised \$4,627 in spite of flooding in the community room on the first day of the sale, which resulted in the loss of many books and moving of the sale to the second floor. Our Fall book sale raised \$5,200. We were assisted in both sales by the Hobart basketball team and the William Smith volleyball team.

Our first ever Geneva Writes event was attended by forty people. Authors John Avanzato, George Goga, Max Justis, Kerry Lippincott, and Molly Pullen read from their works and discussed their writing lives.
